

Manual for creating the individual curriculum (IC)

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I. Getting acquainted with the subject-area curriculum

At the web address plany.ff.cuni.cz, you can acquaint yourself with your subject-area curriculum (SAC). The list expands from left to right, so first you select *single area of study*, then *PhD studies*, then the respective *programme (area of study)*, and finally the year of admission 2022. A link to the respective SAC file is displayed below the table.

We have already entered most of the SAC into your IC in SIS (subjects that are mandatory and identical for all students of the respective area of study). Your task is to add electives and optional items, and to set the year of fulfilment for obligations that you can determine yourself (after agreeing with your supervisor). You can find a list of all items that need to be completed in SIS at the end of each SAC under the heading *Instructions for preparing individual curricula*, e.g.:

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING INDIVIDUAL CURRICULA

The basic version of the IC is created in SIS by the PhD and Academic Qualifications Office, and each PhD student is automatically assigned all obligations that are for all students of the area of study (a unique code is assigned to these obligations in the above curriculum). Once this basic IC has been created, the student, in agreement with the supervisor, must complete the following in SIS:

1. *Foreign language*, which is selected from the list of languages associated in SIS with the specific curriculum.
2. Individual study obligations as specified in the curriculum above. These obligations can be entered either by selecting an already existing subject, or (if the subject does not yet exist in SIS) by entering a “subject description”, which describes the obligation in writing, with the understanding that it will be associated with a certain subject in SIS at a later time.
3. Year of fulfilment for all obligations for which the above subject-area curriculum determines the time period.

At the address is.cuni.cz/studium, you then log in to SIS. If you have more than one choice of user roles, select your current PhD studies. You can then find your IC in the module *Individual Curriculum*:





